NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS CALLING FOR BIDS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the **SAN DIEGO COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT** of San Diego County, California, acting by and through its Governing Board, hereinafter referred to as the DISTRICT, will receive up to, but not later **than 2 o'clock p.m. of the 12th day of April , 2019**, sealed bids for the award of a contract for the:

SOUTHERN CAMPUS SCOPE B
AT MIRAMAR COLLEGE, SAN DIEGO

Bids shall be received in the office of the Owner in Suite 310 at the **SAN DIEGO COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT, 3375 Camino del Rio, South, Suite 310, San Diego, California, 92108** and shall be opened and publicly read aloud at the above-stated time and place.

Each bid must conform and be responsive to the contract documents, copies of which are now on file and may be obtained **after March 19, 2019 at Mayer Reprographics (mayer.com)**. Each bid shall be accompanied by the security referred to in the contract documents, the non-collusion affidavit, the list of proposed subcontractors, and all additional documentation required by the Instructions to Bidders.

Mandatory Pre-Bid Walks will be held as follows: Monday, **April 1, 2019 at 10:00 am** Miramar College, **10440 Black Mountain Rd, San Diego, CA 92126. Park in Parking Garage G4 and meet at the northern sidewalk.** **A site visit is mandatory and should a bidder not attend, they will not be allowed to bid as it is a material requirement of the contract.**

As a condition of bidding and in accordance with the provisions of Section 20651.5 of the California Public Code and Section 20101 of the California Local Agency Public Construction Act, the District is requiring prequalification of all general contractors wishing to submit bids on the project. **Bids will not be accepted if a contractor has not been prequalified and the bid exceeds \$500,000.** **Contractor and all listed subcontractors must be registered under SB854 with the State of California.**

In contracts involving an expenditure in excess of \$ 25,000.00, the successful bidder shall file a payment bond issued by an admitted Surety approved to conduct business in the State of California approved by the District in the form set forth in the contract documents.*

The District reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any irregularities or informalities in any bids or in the bidding.

The lowest responsive bid will be determined solely on the lowest base contract bid. Even if alternate bids are sought by the District, the lowest responsive bid will be based solely on the lowest base contract bid.

*A payment bond must be filed for a contract involving an expenditure in excess of \$25,000 (Civil Code section 3247[a]) and may be required for contracts involving smaller expenditures at the option of the Owner.

The Director of Industrial Relations has determined the general prevailing rate of per diem wages in the locality in which this work is to be performed for each craft or type of worker needed to execute the contract which will be awarded to the successful bidder, copies of which are on file and will be made available to any interested party upon request at the **San Diego Community College District, Facilities Management, 3375 Camino del Rio, South, Suite 310, San Diego, California, 92108.**

It shall be mandatory upon the Contractor to whom the contract is awarded, and upon any subcontractor under him, to pay not less than the said specified rates to all workers employed by them in the execution of the contract.

Labor Compliance Program: The general contractor and every subcontractor that is listed in the bid documents shall be required to comply with the District's Labor Compliance Program.

Each bidder or subsequent tiered bidder shall be a licensed contractor pursuant to the Business and Professions Code and shall be licensed in the following classification: A, B.

No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of **NINETY (90)** days after the date set for the opening of bids.
